FSG emerged as a mysterious label / production outfit releasing 2 key EPs which captivated the entire worldwide Techno scene. The first was co-producer Smear's "Transect" which was an instant hit.

After this came the first release as FSG; "Applied Generics" which sold out almost instantly and was featured on Surgeon's mix for the London club / label; Fabric. The duo followed this up eclectic mixture of releases exploring tangled soundscapes and intricate rhythmic work on a number of labels such as; Perc Trax, Stroboscopic Artefacts, Dynamic Reflection, Audio Assault, Zooloft, and similar.

A debut album on London's Perc Trax; "Labour Division" has seen FSG reach into the wider music industry with a unique brand of Darkwave, Synthpop, IDM, and skull-jacking Techno. The album has been met with universal acclaim and support ranging from Luke Slater to Sasha along with raised media interest (including a small feature in the Guardian newspaper and heavy support from online media such as Resident Advisor). Tracks from Labour Division have been played on Radio 1, as part of Factory Floor's session with the legendary Dan Miller (Mute Records) and also in Blawan's recent set on "BoilerRoom Sessions".

As the FSG legend develops, so have the artists involved, with both Patrick and Al Matthews (Smear) now regularly releasing on many of the most exciting labels in the world under a wide-range of aliases and performing across the globe hitting countries like Germany, USA, Ireland, UK, Holland and Cyprus. They have played at the legendary club; Tresor in Berlin and Walker recently made the journey to play a DJ set at the infamous; Arma17 club in Moscow.
